Start a GreenTennis Chapter @ Your School

4 EASY STEPS

01 Contact your high school's head tennis coach.

- If your high school has different coaches for the girls' and boys' seasons, make sure to reach out to both.

02 Inquire about the tennis balls at your school.

- Ask: (1) What tennis balls are used during the season? {Brand, type, cost} (2) How many cases of balls are used per season? {How many balls in each case?} (3) What happens to the balls at the end of each match / season?

03 Ask about incorporating GreenTennis into tennis program.

- Ask: (1) Can we start recycling our tennis balls? It is an easy process which I am willing to champion. (2) if **yes** - do we have any money to buy shipping labels or bins for the school? (3) Would you be willing to switch to Wilson Triniti tennis balls? They are more eco-friendly, last for longer, are more cost-effective, and are USTA/ITF approved.

04 Take action.

- View the attached sheet to see what you can do with designated amounts of money and how you can start recycling.





Recycling Options

01

Individual Shipping Labels

Here, you would store all your balls until the end of the season, count the balls, then package them into boxes (>100 balls per box), and buy individual shipping labels (\$20 for 6 labels). If your school cannot afford it:

02

Buy an Outdoor Bin

This can be used multiple times and is useful for continuous recycling. However, it must be emptied and shipped into boxes after being full (as listed in option 1 to the left). The outdoor box costs \$185 and 6 shipping labels can be purchased for \$20 (or free if not able to afford).

03

Buy 10 Indoor Boxes

You can set up boxes around your school where you can insert the balls into the boxes. Each box holds 200 balls and contains a prepaid shipping label. Whenever a box is filled, all you have to do is schedule a UPS pickup or simply drop it off at the UPS store.

Start a Continuous Indoor Box Program

The RecycleBalls QuickShip program sends you 10 indoor boxes at a time just like option 3. However, here, when you are running low on boxes, they will send you a new set of 10 boxes. See option 3 for how to ship the boxes. This program is free for the first 3 months, however they require you to pay/acquire a sponsor afterward to continue the program.
